

### Step 1 – How to check your iPad iOS version?

Things are changing with Apple’s firmware all the time. There some problems with current iOS 4.2.1

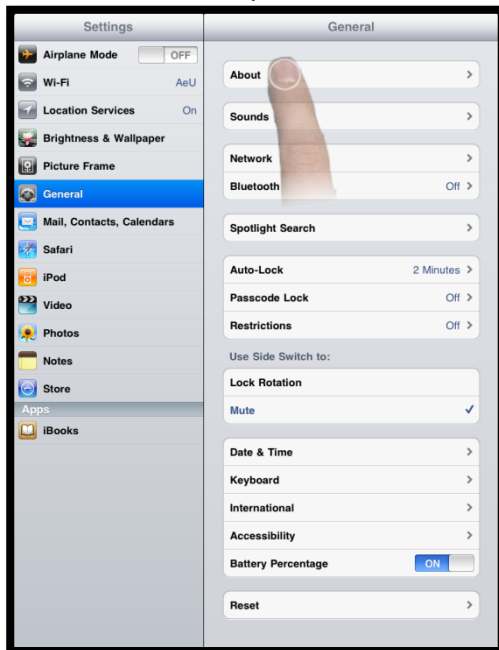
So to enable you to access to our AeU eLibrary & etc.

You need to update your iPad iOS to the current latest iOS. To check see if you have the latest version on your iPad. Here’s how.

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Tap **General** on the left pane.
3. Tap **About**.

You will see a bunch of information such as number of songs, serial number, and the firmware version.

- ✓ If your iPad iOS is **Version 4.3.1** then skip step2, proceed to **Step 3**.
- ✓ If your iPad iOS is **Version 4.2.1** then proceed to next **Step 2**.



## Step 2 - How to Download and Update iOS directly from iTunes

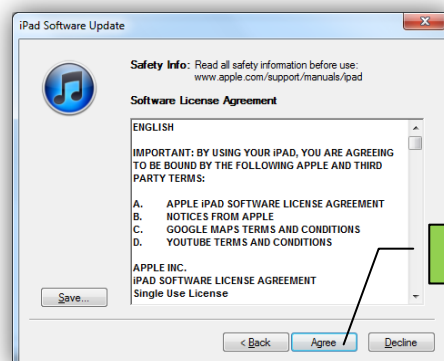
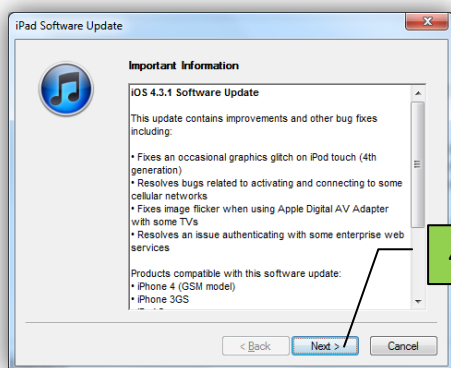
To download and update iOS directly with iTunes for iPad you will have to follow these steps:  
(Make sure you are using iTunes 8 or above. Connect your iPad to your computer.)

1. When iTunes opens, select your iPad under DEVICES iPad list on the left panel.



2. In the iPad Summary panel, click Check for Update.

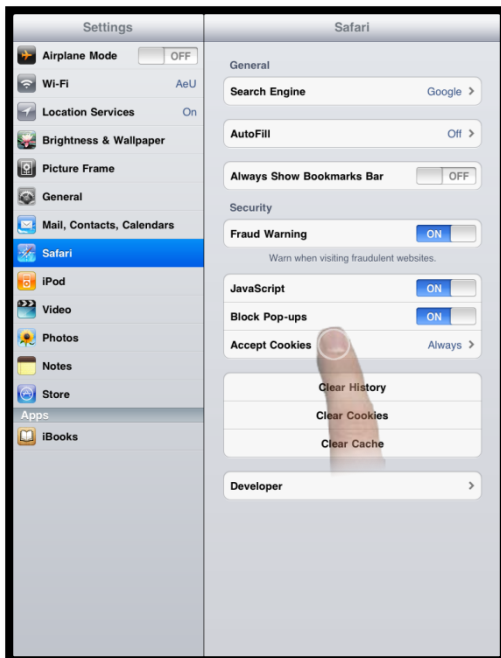
3. Click Download and Update. Then follow the instruction click "Next" and "Agree" button. Wait for iTunes download and update the iPad.  
**\*Do not disconnect your iPad until the update has finished.**



### Step 3 - How to change Safari (iPad web browser) security settings

From the Home screen choose **Settings** > **Safari**, then do one of the following:

To set Safari always accepts cookies, tap Accept Cookies and choose “Always”.



A cookie is a piece of data that a website puts on the device so the website can remember you when you visit again. That way, Webpage can be customized for you based on information you may have provided.

With this setting, user should be able to login to AeU LMS, eLibrary & etc.

**Step 4: (Complete) – Now you're ready to use new updated version of iPad.**
